

Great Stream Commons

Transportation summary

Great Stream Commons is strategically and ideally located in Central Pennsylvania along Interstate 80, America's second-longest interstate. Additionally, the park is located immediately adjacent to US Highway 15, a major north-south trucking and commuting artery.

In 2010 the Joint Rail Authority (a public-private partnership created to re-establish, develop, and expand rail capacity to the region) received a major TIGER II transportation grant to rehabilitate the rail line serving Great Stream Commons. Work on that project has begun, with an anticipated August, 2013 completion date.

Once the rail project is completed, Great Stream Commons will be served by North Shore Railroad. The short line rail road in turn connects to both Norfolk Southern and Canadian Pacific railways approximately 25 miles to the south in Northumberland and Sunbury, respectively.

The nearest commercial airport is located in Williamsport, approximately 15 miles from Great Stream Commons. Harrisburg International Airport, approximately 83 miles away is the nearest major airport, offering passenger and cargo services.
