

## 17<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT TREATMENT COURT FAST FACTS

Treatment Court is a special Court program for adult residents of Snyder and Union Counties who have been charged with non-violent criminal offenses driven by their addiction to drugs or alcohol. The program can be completed in 12 to 18 months. Clients are subject to weekly Court appearances, frequent drug/alcohol testing, intensive substance abuse treatment, intensive supervision and immediate sanctions and incentives. Those who fail to comply with program rules are subject to removal from Treatment Court and resentencing to State Prison. The drug court program is one of four within the State which is accredited by the PA Supreme Court.
