## Judging criteria:

- a. Does the poster contain a written them-related message or statement?
- b. Is the message clear to the observer in 15-30 seconds?
- c. Quality in relation to grade level.
- d. Creativity
- e. Simplicity

## Judging system:

- f. All posters will be displayed at the UCCD Annual Awards Banquet
- g. Each attendant will have an opportunity to vote for the top three posters in each category.
- h. Votes will be tallied and winners will be determined by total votes.
- i. Ties will be broken by UCCD staff.

**Prizes:** Winners of each category will be rewarded.

**Return Policy:** Posters will be returned to no later than June 12, 2020.
