

Mail-In-Ballot Application Instructions

Complete all required information on the Application.

You must supply your PA Driver's License number or PennDOT issued Pennsylvania photo identification card (PennDOT photo ID) number in the blocks provided. If you do not have a driver's license number or PennDOT photo ID number you must supply the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

If you do not have either of these types of identification, please check the box entitled (I do not have a PA Drivers License or a PennDot ID card or a Social Security Number). You must enclose a photocopy of an acceptable ID. Please see www.VotesPA.com/MailBallot, call 1-877-VotesPA (1-877-868-3772) or contact your county election office (570-524-8681) regarding acceptable ID's.

Mail-In voting Deadlines are as follows:

Applications: The last day to apply for a mail-in ballot is 5:00 p.m. on October 27, 2020. Please note that POSTMARKS DO NOT APPLY.

Deadline for returning your mail-in ballot.

- By mail: Your mail-in ballot must be postmarked by 8 p.m. on election day and received by the Union County election office by 5 p.m. on Friday, November 6 to be counted.
- In person: You must return your mail-in ballot to the Union County election office by 8 p.m. on election day.
